ENGAGE: A Different New Nurse Orientation Program

Beyond facility orientation, new nurses also have to orient to their units. In many cases, unit orientation is based on an incremental productivity model; the new nurse is paired with a nurse preceptor, gradually increasing the number of patients assigned to each shift while completing total care for each patient.

2 Ways to Change Your Nursing Orientation Program

Traditional nursing orientation typically consists of 3 to 5 days of "information overload" in an effort to comply with hospital policies and regulations from the state and regulatory organizations such as The Joint Commission. Nursing orientation also introduces newly hired nurses to the hospital's medical records and information systems.
