This was a major expense--169 livres and 16 sous--and involved a hair-raising test administered by a panel composed of the king's first surgeon or his lieutenant, a number of Paris surgeons, various deans of the medical faculty and royal surgical school, the four sworn midwives of Paris attached to the Chatelet, and receivers, provosts, class masters, and council members.
